Cool, easy, quite open but definitely Chablis. Bravo! Good delineation.

Drink 2008-13

Quite a neutral nose but very exciting palate. Liquid somehow. Liqueur finish on palate. Fine, round, good green fruit.

Drink 2009-14

Green fruits nose. Very chewy and lots of acidity. Crunchy fruit. Very searing and steely.

Low-key nose, slightly reminiscent of putty. Chewy. Clear cut, crystalline, looking very good.
